

# Reasons to Fight Your Ticket

## Why should I fight my traffic ticket?

There are many reasons to fight a traffic ticket. The majority of infractions are minor in nature, but can cost you in many 'not so obvious' ways. - Insurance premiums can increase from \$700-\$7000 for driving record blemishes.
- You could receive up to 7 demerit points with one offence. You lose your licence at 15!
- There are ABSOLUTELY no consequences to fighting the ticket. In some cases you don't even have to appear in court.

## A lot of insurance companies offer a "freebie" offence, before it affects your driver rating, so why should I fight?

It is true, some insurance companies do offer these policy incentives, however, why would you use up your 'free' offence on a ticket that you didn't need to? What happens if you get another ticket that you cannot fight as easily? It's always good to have that "freebie" in your pocket for when you really need it.

## What if my charge is more serious than just a traffic ticket?

If you are charged with impaired driving, driving over 80mgs, or any other criminal charge, it is imperative that you utilize our services. The consequences for a conviction for impaired driving include a minimum \$600 fine, a mandatory remedial measure program (\$475), a licence reinstatement fee (\$100), an insurance premium increase (\$3000+), an ignition interlock (\$1500) and lawyer fees (\$2000+).
